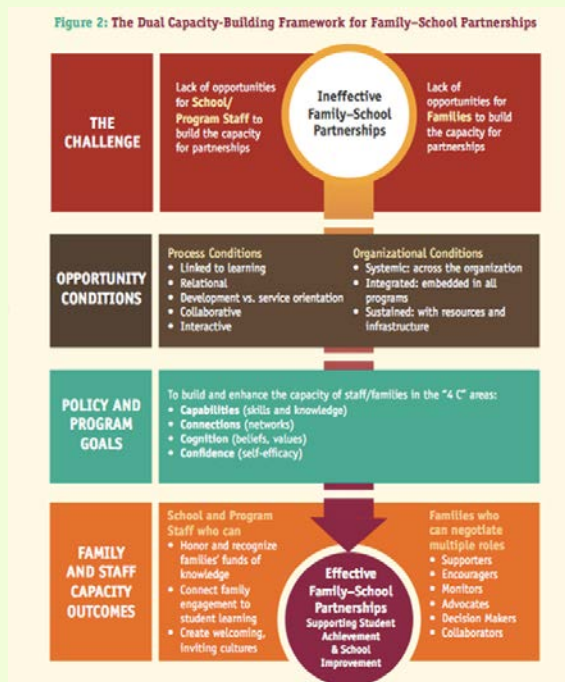

Phonemic Awareness

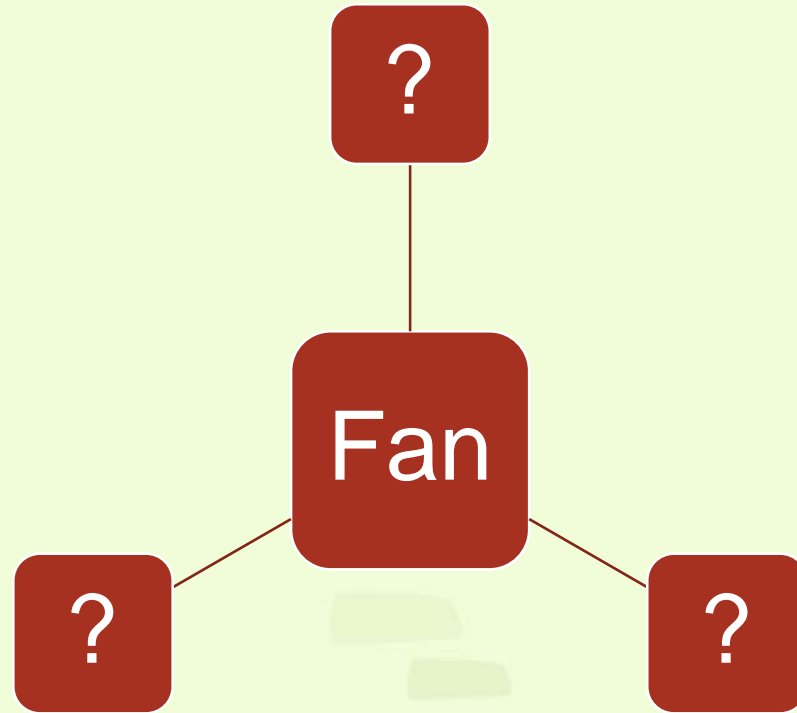
Words are made up of sounds

- Rhyming words – Words that end the same



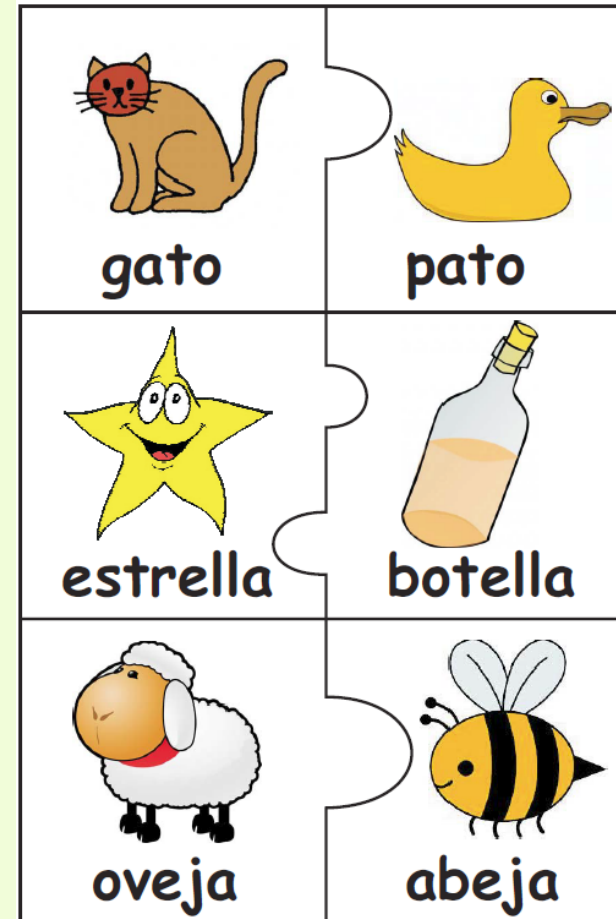
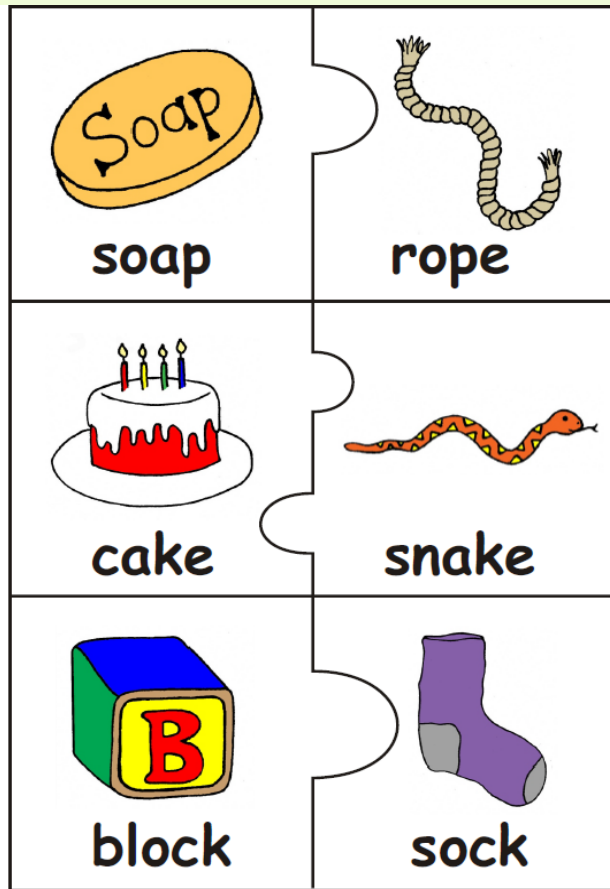

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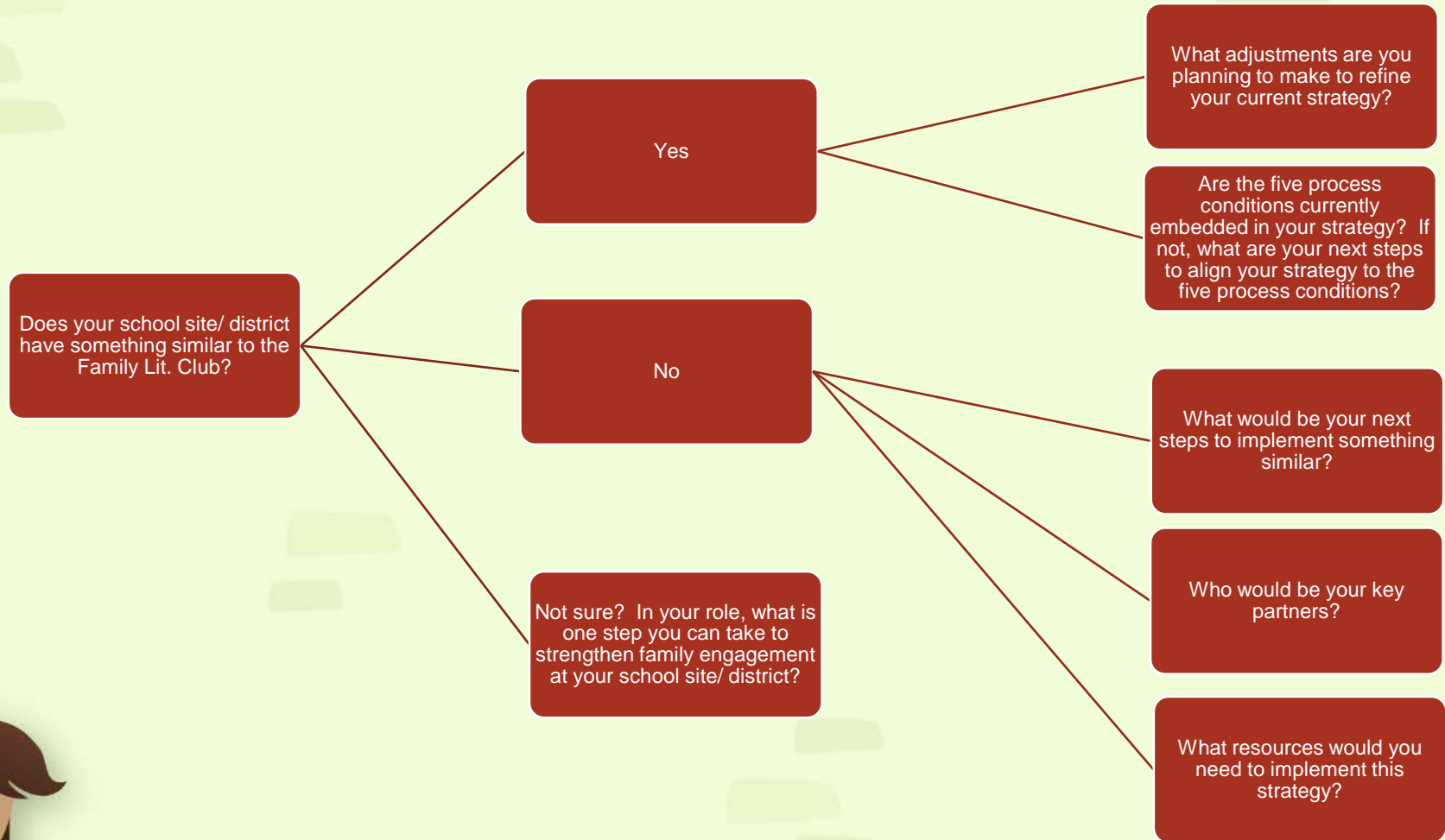
