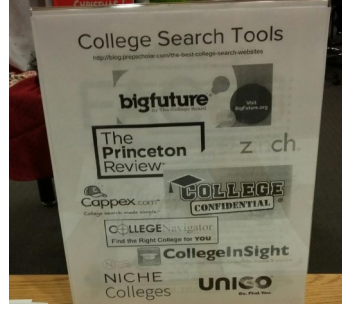


College & Career Readiness Support For Parents and Students

University of Family Learning Workshop (1 –1.5 Hours)	Course Description
<p>Preparing your Child for College and a Future Career</p>	<p>This course provides an overview of career exploration, necessary components of success in high school, the NV labor market, and focuses on the key components and time lines required to successfully be admitted to a college including course selection, extracurricular participation, college entrance exams, college search and best fit, college applications, and funding college. There will be an emphasis on the link between college completion and career choice. Parents of all students (as well as high school students) are encouraged to attend and will leave with the ability to better prepare their children for college and a future career. <i>Presented by CCSD Guidance & Counseling</i></p>
<p>Get College Ready vs. College Eligible</p>	<p>Attendees will learn what it means to be “college-ready” and where high school students currently stand on that score.
